



The University of Denver- Department of Biological Sciences and National Jewish Health- Division of Pulmonary Medicine, Department of Medicine are collaboratively conducting a research study on: **Health Effects of Vaping on Young Adults**. The study will take place in the Physiology Lab in Nagel room 116 at the University of Denver.

You may be eligible if you are **18-25** years old. **Participants will include young adults who frequently vape AND those who never vape/smoke**

This study examining the biological effects of vaping involves a **one-time 2-hour in-person visit at DU**. Participants will complete questionnaires about vaping behaviors and lung symptoms, lung function tests (spirometry & oscillometry), nasal and cheek swabs, saliva, and urine and blood sample collection.
