	Internal Medicine Core: Provision of non-surgical treatment of general medical problems seen in the adult patient population	Requires successful completion of an ACGME or AOA accredited residency in Internal Medicine
	Gastroenterology Core: Admission, history and physical, evaluation, diagnosis, provision of treatment, consultation, and discharge for patients presenting with conditions, disorders or diseases of the organs and systems of the digestive tract and related structures	Requires successful completion of an ACGME or AOA accredited fellowship in Gastroenterology
	Gastroenterology Invasive Procedures Core: Upper (EGD) Endoscopy, Flexible Sigmoidoscopy, Colonoscopy and Polypectomy, Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy (PEG), Esophageal Dilation, Esophageal Sclerotherapy, Esophageal Variceal Banding, Paracentesis (both diagnostic and large volume), Treatment of Hemorrhoids (any non-surgical method)	Requires successful completion of an ACGME or AOA accredited fellowship in Gastroenterology Applicants must also request Gastro Core and Sedation privileges

	Cautery: ablation of minimal tissue (gastric, esophageal, intestinal, colonic)	Documentation of training and competence is required for all privileges in this section

	Breath Testing Interpretation	Requires successful completion of an accredited fellowship in Gastroenterology
	Capsule Endoscopy Interpretation	Requires successful completion of an accredited fellowship in Gastroenterology
	Esophageal Distensibility (Endoflip)	Requires successful completion of an accredited fellowship in Gastroenterology
	GI Motility (Manometry) Interpretation	Requires documentation of training and competence
	Use of Fluoroscopy	Requires State-mandated fluoroscopy training at initial appointment; thereafter, requires annual NetLearning Fluoroscopy module, plus hands-on, machine-specific proficiency review
	Mild to Moderate Sedation	Requires current ACLS and adult moderate sedation certification
