	Pediatrics Core: Provision of non-surgical treatment of general medical problems seen in the pediatric patient population (no procedures included)	Requires successful completion of an ACGME or AOA accredited residency in Pediatrics
	Pulmonary Medicine Core: Admission, history and physical, work-up, diagnosis, provision of treatment, consultation, and discharge for pediatric patients presenting with conditions, injuries or diseases of the organs and systems of the thorax or chest: procedural privileges include Fiberoptic Laryngoscopy, and pleural procedures such as chest tube Insertion, non-emergent intubation, and nasal mucosal sampling	Requires successful completion of an ACGME or AOA accredited fellowship in Pediatric Pulmonary Medicine
	Sleep Medicine Core: Admission, history and physical, evaluation, diagnosis, provision of treatment, consultation, and discharge for patients presenting with conditions or diseases related to sleep mechanics; core includes interpretation of Polysomnography, Multiple Sleep Latency Test, Maintenance of Wakefulness Test, Home Sleep Testing, and Actigraphy	Requires successful completion of an ACGME or AOA accredited fellowship in Pediatric Pulmonary Medicine
Bronchoscopy and Related Procedures		
	Diagnostic Fiberoptic, Bronchoscopy with Bronchoalveolar Lavage, Endobronchial Brushings, Endobronchial Forceps Biopsy, Endobronchial Wash	Requires performance of at least ten Bronchoscopy procedures in each two- year appointment cycle
	Transbronchial Lung Biopsy with or without Fluoroscopy	Requires State-mandated fluoroscopy training at initial appointment; thereafter, requires annual NetLearning Fluoroscopy module, plus hands-on, machine-specific proficiency review
Non-Core Privileges		
	Clinic privileges to provide specialty care to adult patients presenting with diseases typically seen in pediatrics. Specify diseases to treat:	Requires documentation of experience treating adult patients
	Diagnostic Continuous Laryngoscopy (applies to patients of all age ranges)	Special experience required; ACLS required if treating adult patients
	Therapeutic Continuous Laryngoscopy (applies to patients of all age ranges)	Special experience required; ACLS required if treating adult patients
	Mild to Moderate Sedation	Requires current PALS certification
