	<p><b>General Surgical Core:</b> Consultation and evaluation for general surgery patients, including all core surgical competencies and office-based procedures typically learned during standard General Surgery residency. This includes but is not limited to: skin lesion biopsy, skin tag removal, ingrown toenail removal, laceration repair, foreign body removal from ear/nose/skin, incision and drainage of abscess, suture or staple removal, wound care including exploration, packing, debridement and wound-vac changes, feeding tube replacement or removal, drain removal, central line or port removal, soft tissue or lymph node biopsy, evacuation of hematoma, proctoscopy/rectal examination, and nerve or soft tissue injections</p>	<p>Requires successful completion of an ACGME or AOA accredited residency in General Surgery</p>
<p><b>Invasive Procedures</b> (must also request sedation privileges below)</p>		
	<p>Upper Endoscopy (EGD) to include foreign body removal, biopsy, dilation, injection, BARRx, mucosal resection and clipping</p>	<p>Documentation of training and competence is required for all privileges in this section</p>
	<p>Surgical Treatment of Hemorrhoids</p>	
	<p>Insertion of central access catheter or dialysis catheter</p>	
	<p>Insertion of chest tube</p>	
	<p>Colonoscopy to include biopsy, clipping, and injection</p>	
	<p>Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy</p>
