

Dr. Matthew Stratton owns and operates an anesthesiology practice and medical legal consulting firm in Denver. A fifth generation Coloradan, he was born and raised in Denver where he and his family have a long history of civic engagement with the city and state. Dr. Stratton earned a B.S. in Economics from The George Washington University, received his M.D. from Northwestern University Medical School in Chicago, and completed anesthesiology residency at NYU as Chief Resident of his class. During that time, he also worked in the United States Senate, liaised with the African Union Parliament while employed with Save The Children in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. He raised funds to help construct several elementary schools across the globe with Denver and Washington based nonprofits, and traveled to all seven continents. Following residency, Dr. Stratton stayed on at NYU as an associate professor for two years where he taught anesthesiology. He also helped implement policies that minimized the institution's carbon footprint from the operating rooms.
