Featured Trial of the Month

Fighting Atopic Dermatitis (Eczema) Skin Infections – NIAID / NIH

Clinicians: *Do you have a patient age 18-60 with moderate to severe atopic dermatitis?*

Perhaps they could benefit from a **38 day, multicenter, randomized, double-blind, placebo controlled study to assess the safety and efficacy of a topical cream.** Our researchers are trying to determine if a new investigational lotion is safe and if it will reduce, or even eliminate, infection-causing bacteria on the skin of moderate to severe atopic dermatitis patients.
