Do you have your ORCID iD, yet? It is likely all investigators will need an ORCID iD by *this* October.

ORCID stands for Open Researcher and Contributor ID. Eventually the ID will allow you to link your eRA Commons account to various other resources to reduce

your administrative burden. Currently for NIH, your ORCID iD will link to your eRA Commons account so that publications can be easily associated with your grants.

When a 2271 appointment form is submitted for Training and Institutional K awards, eRA systems will check to ensure that the ORCID iD is present in the Personal Profile associated with the Commons IDs listed in the form. Starting this month, a warning will be issued if the ORCID iD is not present. This warning will be switched to an error in October of 2019 and must be cleared to successfully submit the new appointment.

How do you get an ORCID iD? Log into eRA Commons, and go to your Personal Profile. Just under your name and your listed eRA Commons roles, you will find a link to create your <u>ORCID iD</u>. Following that link to <u>ORCID.org</u>, you will be able to register and link your Commons account to your ID.

Featured Trial of the Month -

Hypersensitivity Pneumonitis and the Immune System – Pulmonary Fibrosis Foundation

Clinicians: Do you have a patient age 18-80 with hypersensitivity pneumonitis?

This clinical research study is investigating the underlying immune mechanism in HP in order to target novel therapeutics. We are looking for nonsmoking patients with sub-acute or chronic HP on no immunosuppressive therapy within the past 6 months.

This study consists of 3 study visits and includes research bronchoscopy (9 hours total time). Compensation is provided.
