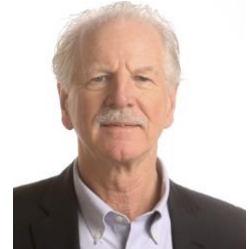

Precision Interventions for Severe/Exacerbating Asthma: PreCISE
