Precision Interventions for Severe/Exacerbating Asthma: PreCISE - NIH Do you have a patient age 12 or older who has severe or uncontrolled asthma? Our researchers are looking to identify different types of severe asthma and understand the best way to treat it based on precision medicine. Patients with uncontrolled, worsening or severe asthma are welcome to participate. This study consists of multiple study visits over the course of 6 months and up to 2 years
