



The National Jewish Health Miners Clinic provides free health screenings and medical follow-up recommendations for:


- Active and former miners (all mined commodities)

Your Health Risks

Western miners can be at risk for lung diseases due to workplace hazards. Exposure to dusts, fumes, smoke, radiation and chemicals place miners at risk for several lung conditions:

- Black Lung
- Chronic Bronchitis
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Emphysema
- Lung Cancer
- Silicosis
- Tuberculosis

Uranium industry workers (miners, millers, ore transporters) and those who worked at or lived near nuclear test sites are at risk for:

- Certain Cancers
- Chronic Kidney Disease
- Lung Disease
