She utilizes the latest clinical tools to help diagnose and treat patients with immunodeficiency. She specializes in the care of patients with common variable immunodeficiency (CVID) and patients with secondary immunodeficiencies such as those caused by cancer and immunosuppressive therapy. Her research focuses pulmonary complications of primary immunodeficiency diseases, including interstitial lung disease and bronchiectasis. By using the latest tools in immunogenetics, she hopes to predict complications and personalize therapies for these conditions. As Clinical Director of the new Adult Immunodeficiency Program at National Jewish Health, Dr. Galant-Swofford will be developing a coordinated, interdisciplinary approach to improving the quality of life for patients with immunodeficiency disorders.
