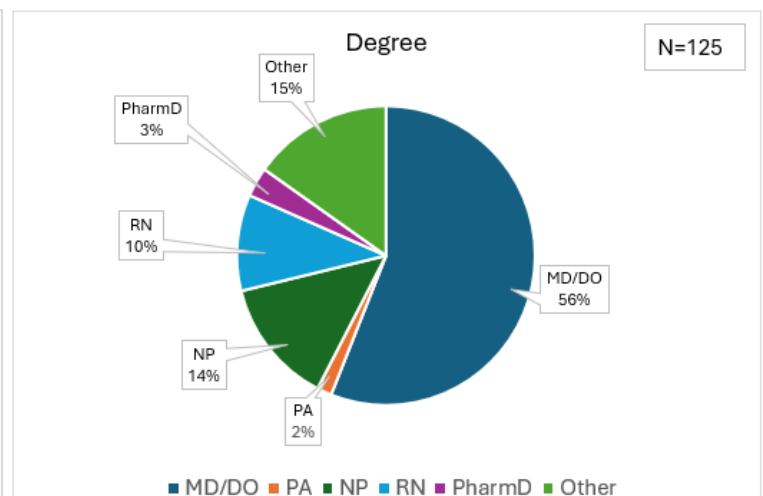
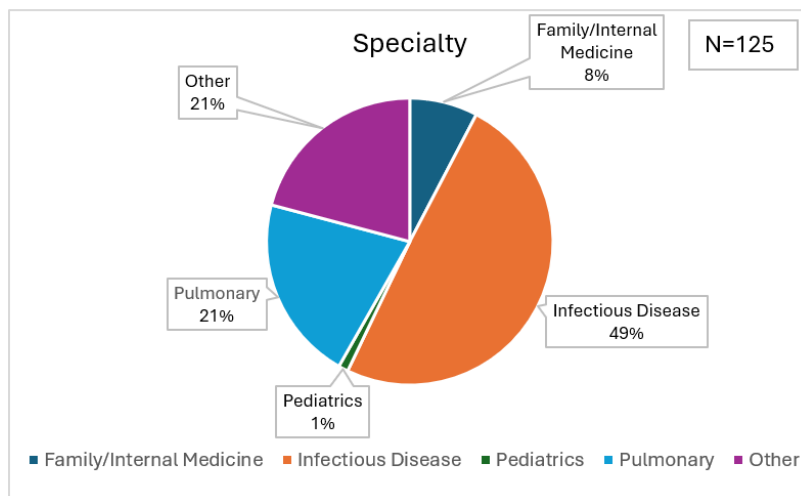

About the Conferences: Nontuberculous mycobacteria (NTM) and bronchiectasis are complex, chronic respiratory conditions that pose significant diagnostic and therapeutic challenges for healthcare providers. The interplay between these conditions contributes to worsening respiratory symptoms, frequent exacerbations, and reduced quality of life for patients.

We will have experts from across the country here to discuss this growing medical challenge. The 2026 meetings will be offered as a hybrid, with the option to attend in-person or online.

Audience: Provider attendees will include pulmonologists, infectious disease specialists, radiologists, respiratory therapists, nurses, and researchers. The 2025 Providers conference had 125 attendees (57 in person and 68 virtual) while the patient and family conference had 533 attendees (90 in person and 443 virtual).
