

Information that must be included and disclosed in your application:

To constitute a complete application, each applicant for initial appointment is required to submit and fully disclose detailed information as follows:

- A fully executed, complete, current and correct Colorado Uniform Provider Credentials Application
- Information concerning education and training
- Information concerning current competence and professional experience related to the requested privileges
- Information about your current health status
- Peer references knowledgeable about your competence and ethical character
- Previously successful or currently pending challenges to any licensure or registration (state or district, Drug Enforcement Administration certificate), or the voluntary relinquishment of such licensure or registration
- All previously or currently held privileges at any healthcare facility
- All incidents of voluntary or involuntary termination of Medical Staff membership, or voluntary or involuntary limitation, reduction, or loss of clinical privileges at another hospital
- Any involvement in a professional liability action, including claims, judgments, settlements, and/or pending legal actions, including convictions of a criminal offense
- Request for specific clinical privileges
- Copies of all documents listed on the application materials checklist
- Must be eligible to participate in Medicare and Medicaid programs, free from any sanctions or exclusions from the programs
- Any additional evidence of current ability to perform privileges that may be requested by Medical Staff Services or the Credentialing Committee
