

Gary Smith, PhD, Hired to Lead Advanced Diagnostics Laboratories

"We are positioning ourselves to experience significant growth in our commercial reference testing segment, especially in the molecular diagnostic arena. Likewise, the other major component of growth over the next three to five years is in our pharmaceutical/contract research organization (CRO) business segment. This area is driven by our bio marker research coupled with both our immune monitoring and complement expertise."
